

Dear Meet Director,

There are several questions often asked about hosting a qualifying meet. The following information and attached documents should provide answers to most of your questions.

1. USATF/Iowa Association fee - the fee due to USATF/Iowa Association for hosting a qualifying meet is \$110. This fee covers:

- Club membership (\$40) - includes 2010 USATF rule book
- Meet sanction and insurance (\$70) - insured to \$2,000,000
  - covers anyone competing or working
- Awards - ribbons
- USATF membership card forms
- State meet entry forms

2. Receipts: Meet entry fee is \$4 or \$5 per athlete.  
We recommend a spectator admission fee of \$2 or \$3.

The meet host may retain these profits, after the \$110 fee is paid.

3. The athlete is allowed to participate in several events. The Sub Bantam (SA), age 8 and under, Bantam (A), age 9-10, and the Midget (B) age 11-12 groups are allowed to compete in up to 3 events. All other age groups are allowed to compete in 4 events. The events may be any mix of running or field events. Please see attached Order of Events sheet for eligible age group participation events.
4. Hurdle settings differ from high school settings. Please see the attached specification sheet for setting specifications. These are mandated by USATF rules. Also on the sheet are the mandated weights for the throwing implements for the various age groups.
